

2020 Sherman Tourney Report

The first tournament event for 2020 was held at Sherman Reservoir last weekend 10/19 - 10/20. The weather was typical for mid-October but was not a big factor in the outcome. It was a two-day tournament with the weight of two days being added together to determine the overall winner.

28 teams participated with 18 NWA teams competing for points toward the 2020 top gun. The slot limit on Sherman is two fish 15–20 in and one fish over 28 in. This limited the number of fish that could be brought to the scales. Several fish over 20 in but under 28 in were caught, measured and returned to the water. A total of 89 walleye were brought to the scale, with no fish over the 28 in limit.

The tournament was won by Blake Power and Blake Covey who caught 4 fish each day for a total weight of 17.36 lb. and are cashing a check for \$2,714. The event paid down 6 places 2nd place paid \$1,422, 3rd \$1,072, 4th \$786, 5th \$644 and 6th \$500.

Big fish paid \$480 each day. Trade Winds Marina contributed \$500 to the total for big fish. Many thanks to them for all that they did for us.

Fish were caught on crank baits and jiggging spoons several places on the lake in 18 - 30 ft. Anything silver with flash seemed to work.
